The DMC threads used in this design are as follows:-

Bundle 1

310 - Black - 8 metres

414 - Steel Grey dk.-18 metres

Bundle 2

3799 - Pewter Grey vy.dk. - 18 metres

415- Pearl Grey-10 metres

A 35 metre card of Madeira Glissengloss Gold 7 is also used although any other gold blending filament can be substituted if preferred..

Please note thread usage is approximate only and might have a slight variation depending on individual stitching methods.

A Windy Day Stitching Notes

Approximate Design Size 14.3 ins x 9.5 ins (36cms x 24cms)

This design can be stitched on 14 count aida or 27/28 count evenweave over 2 x 2 threads and is stitched in Blackwork (worked in backstitch or stab-stitch) and cross-stitch.

The 4 small arrows, one appearing at the edge of each of 4 pages of the chart, are to enable you to centre the design on your fabric. Please note that to make moving from 1 page of the chart to another easier there is a 2 line shaded overlap on pages 2-4, where the adjoining 2 lines from the previous page are duplicated.

General

In the Blackwork part of the design the thicker lines usually outlines are stitched in 2 strands of the appropriate colour, the thinner lines e.g. the infill patterns are stitched in 1 strand. Where darker lines appear over the infill pattern e.g. on the ladies' sleeves these should be put in after the underlying infill pattern is completed.

Cross-strokes are in 2 strands of the thread shown in the key. Where a half-stitch is used a diagonal line is shown across the square with the appropriate symbol behind it.

Where a shade other than Black is used in the blackwork part of this design, instructions for each section are given below.

Lady on Left

The infill pattern on her sash or obi is in 1 strand of DMC 414 and the outline of this as it appears behind her is outlined in 2 strands of the same.

The blackwork pattern on her sleeves and her lower collar is in 1 strand of DMC 3799; the outline of the collar, sleeves and the folds in the sleeve are in 2 strands of the same.



Please note the left hand is in 1 or 2 strands of DMC 310.

Lady on the Right

The infill pattern of her gown is in 1 strand of DMC 310. Her sash or obi is stitched in 2 strands of Gold blending filament.

Her sleeve lining is outlined in 2 strands of DMC 414 and the infill pattern in 1 strand of the same.



The pattern on her underdress is stitched in 1 strand of DMC 3799




Her lower collar stitched in the checkerboard pattern in DMC 3799 is outlined in 2 strands of the same.

The Umbrella

Stitched mainly in DMC 310 part of the umbrella support has infill lines. The outline of this part is in 2 strands of DMC 3799.

Part A and C (vertical and diagonal lines) are in 1 strand DMC 3799

Part B (vertical lines) is stitched in 2 strands of Gold blending filament.



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The Knight

The knight, the doorway he stands in and his helmet are outlined in 1 or 2 strands of DMC 3799. Where a thicker line is shown please use 2 strands of thread but stitch the thinner lines in 1 strand. The infill pattern of his chainmail is also stitched in 1 strand of DMC 3799.



His Cloak

Outlined in 2 strands of DMC 3799 the fold lines are in 2 strands of the same.

The outer cloak infill pattern is in 1 strand of DMC 414.



The inside of his cloak in the darker line is in 1 strand of DMC 3799.



Border

The stems of the gold berries are in 2 strands of DMC 310.

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




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
